Bruce Edward Person was born November 12, 1951 in St. Louis, Missouri to the union of Bobbie (Brownlee) and George E. Person. His grandparents and father, George Edward Person, preceded him in death. He was the oldest of two children. He and his brother enjoyed hanging out with their friends in the neighborhood and playing sports in the alley, of course, making sure they were home before the street lights came on.

He received his education through the St. Louis public school system where he earned his high school diploma in 1970 from Northwest High School. Later he attended Harris-Stowe State University and Ranken Technical College. After finishing at Ranken Technical College as a auto mechanic, his first job was working for the teamsters as a mechanic on the freight dock until that company moved out of state. He, then, worked for many years at Hostess Wonder Bread until his retirement in 2003. After he retired, he worked as a Skycap at the St. Louis Lambert International Airport.

He was a great father where he enjoyed taking Cortney to dance and Jason to his sports events.
