Clifford Hampton was conceived into this world on May 2, 1930, by parents Jesse and Gertrude Hampton in the City of Saint Louis, Missouri. He was the oldest of two boys. His father Jesse, mother Gertrude, and younger brother Jesse Hampton Jr. preceded him in death.

Raised by his parents in the City, Clifford was well educated through the St. Louis Public Schools receiving graduate diplomas from Divoll School.

Clifford enjoyed the simple things such as walks, sightseeing, sitting with

fellow veterans sharing stories about his time in the Navy, and the things he got to see, he was a very wise man, he believed that although no man is created perfect in the eyes of GOD all men were created equal. Clifford was a well-known member at True Life Baptist Church.

Clifford left this world peacefully on February 15, 2022, at the age of 91. Preceding him in death was his ex-wife Shirley Mae Hampton, Mary Valentine, and last known love Louetta Hughes, four children Cynthia, Clifford, Lorraine, Arvin, and one grandson Nathaniel.
