Marcella Hytche Page, in her 86th year, transitioned from life to eternal rest Tuesday, January 19, 2021 from her home in St Louis, MO.

Marcella was born on June 17, 1935 to Geneva Hogan and Elbert Hytche in Muskogee, OK. Marcella lost her mother at the early age of 4 years old and was raised by her aunt, Mary E. Hogan Wright. She attended Muskogee Public Schools and graduated from Manual Training High School. After graduating high school, she started her life journey by moving to St. Louis, MO. She began working in the field of Nursing at Barnes Jewish Hospital and continued as she attended the Barnes Jewish School of Nursing receiving her License Practical Nursing certificate. Marcella later attended Forrest Park Community College where she received her Bachelor of Science in Nursing. Marcella continued her professional career at Barnes Jewish Hospital where she was employed there for 34 years until her retirement on December 31, 1997.

Marcella met the love of her life, Ike Page in St. Louis and they were married on April 29, 1956. They became the proud parents of a baby boy, Renwick Anzaro Page on October 31, 1964.

Marcella joined the church at an early age. She was a faithful member of the Pine Lawn Glen Echo Baptist Church in St Louis where she was a member of the church choir and served on the Mother Board.

Marcella had a sweet loving spirit and touched the lives of many with kind words, jokes to make sure there was always laughter or even just the

presence of her love. She loved playing cards, fishing and most of all family gatherings. In those moments she made lifelong relationships and left heartfelt impressions with everyone she met. She will truly be missed by so many who knew and loved her; heaven has truly gained another angel.
