



Dr. Oswald Lee Thomas

August 21, 1953 - May 24, 2021

Oswald Lee Thomas was born to Vergie Mae Gardner on August 21st, 1953 at the historic Homer G. Phillips Hospital in St. Louis, Missouri. He was later adopted by her husband Israel Thomas.

After graduating from Northwest High school, he attended the University of Missouri-Columbia earning a Bachelor's Degree. It was there he became a member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity Inc. This was followed by attendance at the University of Missouri-Kansas City where he earned his Doctorate in Dental Surgery. It was there he met Mary Crumbley whom he married and to their union three lovely children were born. They later divorced but remained close friends.

Oswald dedicated his life to practicing dentistry first in private practice in University City and more recently in public health serving the Greater St. Louis community at Care STL. One of the highlights of his career was serving as the first African-American President of the Missouri Dental Board. His mission in private practice and public health was service to those with difficulty accessing care. He was bilingual and enjoyed speaking Spanish to Hispanic patients. He practiced dentistry for 38 years.

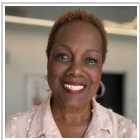
