Mr. Ralph Hunter was born on March 8, 1931, to the late Albert and the late Leora (Smith) Hunter in Foristell, Mo. Ralph was the baby of 11 children. He was raised in the Wentzville area.

Ralph was united in holy matrimony to Geneva (Morton) on January 2, 1958, by Rev. Lewis Strong. To this union 5 children were born.

Ralph worked on the family farm and for other area farmers at an early age. His love for farming was a constant his entire life. Ralph had an extensive work history. At the age of 15 he worked for the Katy Railroad (you had to be 16 to get that job, so he “upped” his age). Ralph worked there for 5 years, the Wabash Railroad for 2 years, the Stave Mill for 7 years, Isreal Brothers Construction for 18 years, S&T Hauling for 7 years, Hunter’s Hauling for 10 years, Metro Waste for 6 years and St. Charles Community College for 22 years. Ralph retired at the age of 81! Ralph was a very hard worker with an AMAZING work ethic, that was truly to be admired. He had many letters of recognition from his years working at the college. Ralph was a member of the Pleasant Valley M. B. Church for many years, where he served faithfully on the Usher board.
