Roosevelt Boldwin was born February 19, 1919 in Adams County, Mississippi to the union of David and Amanda Boldwin. To this union 6 children were born, James, Dora, Tamma, Susie, George and Roosevelt. His parents along with brothers James and George and sister Dora have preceded him in death. Roosevelt attended public schools in the state of Mississippi. In 1942 he enlisted in the U.S. Army working there as an Auto Service Station attendant. While enlisted he earned 5 decorations and citations: The American Theatre Medal, Asiatic Pacific Theatre Medal, Phillipine Liberation Ribbon, Good Conduct Medal and the World War II Victory Medal. Roosevelt earned an Honorable Discharge in February, 1946.

After his service he moved to St. Louis. Roosevelt became employed at the Brown Shoe Company where in 1972 he met and married Alice. They had a wonderful life together. They belonged to different traveling groups after they retired which they truly enjoyed. Alice preceded Roosevelt in death along with a stepdaughter, Ernestine Micheau.

Roosevelt's other favorite pastime was playing cards every Thursday at the Wohl Center. He will be greatly missed by this group.

Roosevelt transitioned on May 20th after a brief illness. He leaves to cherish his memory 2 sisters Tamma Estes and Susie Sloan, nieces, nephews other relatives and friends.
